Advent is known as a season of "waiting" - for the Christ child to be born anew in our hearts, for God to "create a new heaven and a new earth" for Christ to come again and for the reign of God to come to this world.

But the "waiting" for the arrival of Christ can be challenging. As Rhonda Britten describes it in her book Fearless Living, "when we passively wait, we are living in fear." What she is referring to is that when we wait for circumstances outside of ourselves to change in order to feel hope, peace, joy, or love or to live our lives fully, we rob ourselves of the chance to have those things right now. Cultivating those things means we accept and claim our agency to make our lives our own and move freely into the future no matter the circumstances of our lives or the world around us. And when we do that, we are living fully into whom God calls us to be because we have the power to make a difference—to help shift circumstances—rather than live in fear of them.

So... the "waiting" in Advent cannot be passive, the kind of waiting that believes that God doesn't need us in order to make the world a safer, better place for all people. This is the message that the angels who appear to Zechariah, Mary, Joseph, and the shepherds bring to us. They invite participation in the story. The message is "God is doing thus-and-such" and "you are a part of it." Get over your fear because God is in need of you. And in order for all this to happen, we are going to need more hope, more peace, more joy, more love, and more life all around. God needs you to spread the word.

May you see the angels in your lives and be the angels for others.




Step 1

Go to Simpson's website at www.simpsonumc.com and click on the "Give Online" button.




Step 3

Enter your payment information and click the "Continue to review" button.




Step 2
